## Tank Mural Project



The Peninsula Women's Health Centre has been successful in obtaining a Community and Cultural Grant from Gosford City Council to facilitate an arts project. This project is to paint a mural on a large cement tank within the grounds of the Peninsula Women's Health Centre.

We invite women to participate in the project. This will involve contributing ideas, to plan the mural and then to paint it. Women do not need any artistic skills. The project will be led by community artist Suzanne Holman who has had years of experience working on community arts projects. Suzanne says "the care of inclusion of the community's ideas, passing on new skills and encouraging participants in a positive way is my main objective. The end product should be a wonderful celebration of their new-found skills and energy. Projects such as this connect individuals in communities and give them a sense of place."

**The project will commence with a meeting of interested women on Thursday 20<sup>th</sup> October from 10.am to 12 noon.** At this meeting you will meet Suzanne and other participants. We will do a site walk to see what we are painting. We will take photos, brainstorm ideas for themes and concepts; look at colour choices and other general ideas.

**The next meeting will be held on Thursday 27<sup>th</sup> October from 10.00am to 12.30.** In this meeting women will come back with their sketches, images and ideas. Suzanne will have computer gear that can scan, print, enlarge and reduce etc, for printouts in colour. After a discussion as to who has brought what and the direction we should go, we will start to narrow down the concept. Suzanne will also provide a (to scale) model so that they can see what the design is like wrapped around the tank.

**The third meeting will be held on Thursday November 3<sup>rd</sup> from 10.00am to 12.30pm.** Suzanne will present back to the group the design for comment/ approval. There will be an opportunity to add or delete things and a final agreement on the design will be made. A programme will be handed out for the painting process.

Childcare will be available and a gold coin donation is requested. To be a part of the project we need you to book your spot on the above peninsula number, email or drop in on Tuesday morning from 9.30am to 12.30pm or Wednesday and Thursday from 9.30am to 3.00pm when we are open.
